Sgt. G. R. Degree In German Exercise

HAHN, Germany — U. S. Air Force Sergeant Gus R. Degree, son of Mr. and Mrs. Quinn D. Degree of 324 Sumter St., Shelby, N. C., is participating in a massive NATO training exercise in West Germany.

Sergeant Degree is an aircraft mechanic on the Holloman AFB, N. M., team supporting F-4 Phantom aircrews flying in the month-long maneuver — the second in a projected series of exercises being held as part of the U. S. contribution to increase NATO readiness. Ninety-six Phantoms, based at Holloman and Mountain Home AFB, Idaho, but still committed to NATO, made the transoceanic flight with mid-air refueling. The fighter-bomber crews, redeployed to the U. S. from Germany in 1968, are operating from their former home stations at Tahn, Spandahlem, Bitburg and Ramstein air bases.

Approximately 2,400 Tactical Air Command aircrew members and support personnel are taking part in the exercise.

- **TEXTILES**—Import quotas on textiles to prevent the disastrous competition by foreign textiles which is now costing American jobs.

- **PEACE**—An end to the war in Vietnam through President Nixon's plan for a phased withdrawal of American fighting men and the training of the South Vietnamese to defend themselves.

- **SPENDING CUTS**—Turning away from the "big spender" philosophy and cuts in Federal spending to restore a balanced budget as an important means for bringing under control the inflation.
- **CHANGE**—Changing leadership in Congress to remove from power the same Democratic Party Committee Chairmen who masterminded the disastrous programs of the Johnson Administration and who now oppose sound reforms.
- **VOLUNTEER ARMY**—An all-volunteer Army to replace the draft as soon as defense requirements permit.
- **FOREIGN AID CUTS**—Further cuts in the foreign aid program.
- **DEFENSE**—A continuing strong defense and insistence that our allies shoulder more of the costs of their own defense.
- **ENVIRONMENT**—Strong Federal laws coordinated with the State and local efforts to meet the challenge of air and water pollution, improved conservation practices, and increased park and recreation facilities.
- **RURAL DEVELOPMENT**—Broadening economic development of rural areas to stem migration to the cities where facilities and economic opportunities are already strained.
- **VETERANS AND SOCIAL SECURITY**—Increases in Social Security and Veterans benefits to make certain that the greatest burden of inflation does not fall on those least able to pay.
