Wesleyan Methodists Name Officers

The district board of administration in conjunction with the district board of the Kernersville district is concentrating on realignment of churches within the district, a local pastor said. It is hoped that this may be finalized for adoption by the next annual session.

The Colfax district of the Wesleyan church held its 92nd Annual Session at the Shady Grove Camp, July 27-28 at Colfax, North Carolina. The District Superintendent, Reverend Watson C. Black, along with assistant superintendent, J. W. Phillips presided. The general superintendent, Dr. B. H. Phaup, of Marion, Indiana, served as special representative to the session for the denomination. This conference reported 94 churches in the state of North Carolina. There were 127 ministers seated, and 124 lay delegates seated as elected by the local churches. The conference officials were elected.

Substantially less than half the workers in the nation's private sector are covered by private retirement plans, the Bureau of Labor Statistics reports.
