will be held on September 4th. The program will be opened with the presentation of the flag, the national anthem and invocation. Judges will be Ed Becker of Hopkins, S. C., English division, and Bunky Carter of Eastover, S. C., Western division. Master of ceremonies will be Hubert Panther of Kings Mountain and Fred Biggerstaff of

Frosh Courses May Be Offered

College courses will be offered at the high school this fall if there is sufficient interest, Bill Bates, high school faculty member said yesterday.

Mr. Bates said regular freshman college courses will be offered to interested people who can receive college credits toward an Associate in Arts degree or upgrade certificates.

English 101, freshman math, psychology, creative writing, and zoology are a few of the subjects which can be offered if there is enrollment of 10 students per class.

Upon completion of each course, the student would receive three quarter hours credit and could earn up to 90 plus hours in the night classes.

Cost is \$7.50 per course and the student would be required to purchase books, said Bates.

Mr. Bates said interested prospective students are invited to contact the high school for registration.

The board of education Monday night tentatively honored requests for reassignments by 34 students.

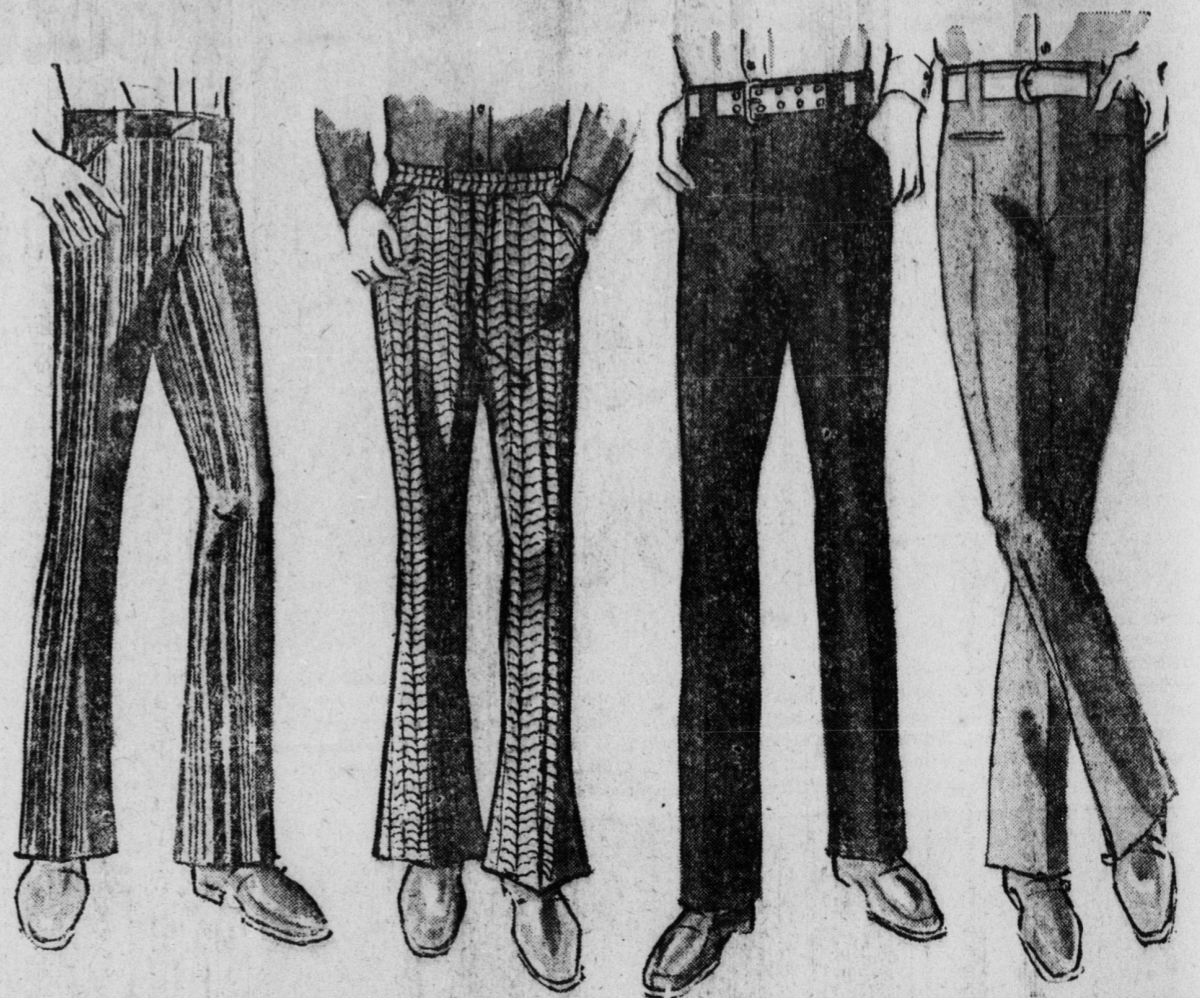
