## WNCHSAA Dissolves

The Western North Carolina High Schools Activities Association, of which Kings Mountain High School is a charter member, dissolved at a meeting Monday Mooresville.

The meeting was called to consider a realignment teams within the

association, but before that proposal could come to a vote, members voted to dissolve and apply for membership in the larger North Carolina High School Athletic Association.

The move will mean one association for all high schools in the state,

therefore providing the opportunity to crown true state champions in every sport.

The WNCHSAA was formed in 1929 and includes four conferences the Southwestern, of which KMHS is a member; the Northwestern, South Piedmont and North Pledmont.

The association currently has 38 members.

The dissolvement of the association will take effect at the end of the current school year.

The meeting Monday was called to try to realign the Northwestern Con-

## KM Girls Defeat R-S, 3-2

Elizabeth McGill singled home Phyllis Mack with the winning run in the bottom of the sixth inning and Sallee Durham's relay throw from the outfield gunned down the tying run at the plate in the seventh Wednesday afternoon at Lancaster Field as Kings Mountain High's girls soft-ballers edged R-S Central 8-2 in a Southwestern

Conference softball game. The victory gives Coach Kathy Brooks' Mountainettes a 4-4 SWC record heading into season-ending road games against Burns and South Point.

KMHS held a 3-1 lead going into the seventh. With two away, R-S Central gained life on an error. A triple enabled the visitors to cut the margin to 3-2 but KM won the game when the three-base hitter tried to stretch her hit into an inside the park home run.

Teresa Blalock went the distance on the mound for KMHS, hurling a three-hitter and striking out one. Four different players had a hit apiece for the Mountainettes.

KMHS dropped a 9-6 decision to East Rutherford last week. Priscilla Rickenbacker and Angle Hickman hit home runs for the Mountainettes.

Third baseman Durham played a sparkling defensive game for the Mountainettes, getting a half dozen putouts and several assists. The Mountainettes played errorless defense until the seventh inning miscue gave R-S Central its comeback opportunity.




