Broyhill Recommended To Stay On Committee

The office of Congressman James T. Broyhill announced today that the Committee on Committees of the House Republican Conference has recommended that the veteran congressman from Lenoir remain on the House Budget Committee and the Interstate and Foreign Commerce Committees during the 96th Congress.

Broyhill who is beginning his 8th term in the House of Representatives will be the 2nd ranking Republican on both the Budget and Commerce Committees. Broyhill stands 18th in seniority among all House Republicans.

The budget committees in both the House and Senate have become increasingly powerful since their creation roughly 2 years ago. The House Budget Committee is expected to be the major Congressional battleground on the question of the government's spending and revenue levels.

The influential Interstate and Foreign Commerce Committee has perhaps the broadest legislative jurisdiction in the House of Representatives. Some of the major legislative issues expected to come before the Commerce Committee this Congress include National Health Insurance, Regulation of Natural Gas, No-fault Automobile Insurance and Major Revision of the Comprehensive Comprehensive Act. "I look forward to another two years of service on these two key House Committees," Broyhill said. "The legislative decisions made during the next two years in the Budget & Commerce Committees will effect the lives of virtually every American. I look forward to the privilege and the continued opportunity of making known the views of the people of North Carolina's 10th district during the deliberations of these two powerful committees," Broyhill concluded.
