## Gaston Students Can Transfer To G-W

**BOILING SPRINGS** — Dr. Joseph L. Mills, president of Gaston College, and Dr. Craven Williams, president of Gardner-Webb College have announced a cooperative program which will facilitate the transfer of credits from Gaston College to Gardner-Webb College.

Current students at Gaston College will now be

able to continue their studies and earn a baccalaureate degree from Gardner-Webb through either its Evening College or regular daytime program.

Courses in the Evening College will begin March 29 with two courses, corporate finance and U. S. government, taught over a six-week term. Additional Evening College course offerings will be available

in two summer terms and a full schedule of Evening College courses will begin with the fall semester, 1977.

"Although we currently have a number of Gaston College students at Gardner-Webb, this cooperative program will greatly simplify the transfer process," stated President Williams. "Gaston College students, have been quite successful at Gardner-Webb. We are pleased that the mechanics of transferring and the necessary counseling procedures have been worked out to enable more Gaston College students to continue their work at Gardner-Webb."
