DENVER - Officials of the sponsoring East Lincoln Optimist Club reported today that plans are shaping up well for the 15th annual J. E. Mainer Memorial Fiddlers and Bluegrass Convention.

The fund-raising effort is scheduled for Fri., Mar. 11, 8 p. m. til midnight and Sat. Mar. 12, noon til after midnight at the Rock Springs School in Denver.

Larry Black, convention chairman stated that judging from interest already shown musicians and country music fans, the event promises to top the previous record of 2,000 spectators and 50 bands.

Black called the event "a southeastern states championship event" and can back up this statement. String musicians from N. C., S. C., Va., Tenn. and Ga. attended last year.

These groups are after the applause from the audience and the \$1,000 in prizes doesn't exactly discourage them. "It looks like we're going to have another outstanding show," Black said.

A new category of competition that is being added this year will be team clogging. Fifteen clogg teams are presently entered in the contest which will begin at 1 p. m. Sat., Mar. 12. Other categories of competition will include old time and bluegrass band, fiddle, guitar, banjo, mandolin, bass, buck dancing, hog calling, and ham bone contest.

Special guest both days will be World Champion Fiddler Curley Fox from the Grand Ole Opry in

Nashville, Tenn. The convention honors the memory of the legendary J. E. Mainer who is regarded as the granddaddy of old time country music.




