Tar Heels Urged To Donate

Mrs. John L. McCain, chairman of the Democratic Party urges North Carolinians to designate \$1 on their income tax return to the political party of their choice. The North Carolina General Assembly approved the tax check off for state income tax payers in the 1975 session (G. S. 105-155.2). This will not increase a

person's taxes or decrease the amount of their refund. This is identical to the federal tax check off which goes to Presidential candidates of both parties during the primary and is available to nominees of

both parties during the general election campaign. Money from the North Carolina check off goes to established political parties for general election use. Mrs. McCain said, "The

tax check offs on federal and state income tax are not solely in the interest of the Democratic Party but in the interest of better government for North Carolina and our nation. I urge all North Carolinians concerned with having good government on the state and national levels to check off \$1 on both their federal and North Carolina income tax forms."

More Tax Credit Is Possible

An easing of the qualifications for claiming the earned income credit will make it possible for more than 100,000 low-income workers in North Carolina to claim up to \$400 on their Federal income tax return.

To qualify, a worker must file a tax return and must have made less than \$8,000 in earned income during 1976; provided more than half the cost of maintaining a home for himself and one child under 19 years old, or a full-time student or a disabled independent.

Earned income is that from wages, salaries, tips, other types of employe compensation and net earnings from self-employment.

The credit is figured as 10 percent of earned income up to \$4,000, and is reduced for incomes of more than \$4,000 by the amount between that figure and \$8,000, where it is phased out.

Here's an example: let's say you made \$4,500 in earned income during 1976. You file a joint return with your spouse and meet the child qualification. Your credit would be \$350, arrived at by taking the \$400 maximum figure and reducing it by 10 percent of \$500, the excess over \$4,000 you earned.

Another good thing; any money you receive as an earned income credit will not be counted as income to you when determining your eligibility for any Federally-funded public assistance program.

Remember, the earned income credit will not come to you automatically. You must file a Federal tax return to claim it. Check your tax instructions or call the IRS toll-free at 1-800-822-8800.
