

Mounties Lose 2-0 To Raiders Friday

South Point's winning run, which was unearned, came in the third when Randy Moss singled, went to third on a throwing error by KM catcher Scott Ellis and scored on a single by Danny Barker. South

Point's final run came in the fourth on an inside the park home run by Joe Shepherd.

Conner started out like a ball of fire, fanning five of the first six Mountaineers before Kevin Tinsley reached on an error to

open the third inning. Tinsley moved to second on a passed ball but stayed there as Andy Loftin fanned. Bruce Valentine popped up and Jimmy Hall fanned to end the inning.

KM missed several scoring chances during the late innings, leaving a runner on third in the fourth, leaving the bases loaded in the fifth and stranding men on second base in the sixth and seventh frames.

Robinson singled and stole second with one away in the fourth, then moved to third on Steve Lancaster's infield out. But Ellis struck out to end the inning.

In the fifth, singles by pinch-hitter Tim Whitaker and Valentine, and a walk to Loftin loaded the bases with just one away. But Conner struck out Hall and Bryan White flied out to leftfield to end that threat.

That put Conner over the hump, even though the final two KMHS baserunners got into scoring position (second).

In the sixth, Lancaster singled with one away and his pinch-runner, Jody Deaton, stole second. But Ellis and Danny Bolin flied out to center to end the inning.

Wilson singled to lead off the final inning and moved to second on Loftin's sacrifice, but Valentine flied out and Hall grounded to shortstop to end the game.

In sharp contrast, the Red Raiders didn't have a man on base except during the third and fourth innings, when they scored their runs.

Robinson put down the first six Raiders before Moss' leadoff single in the third. The Raiders left the bases loaded after Moss scored the winning run.

After Shepherd's homer to lead off the fourth, Robinson gave up a single to designated hitter John Lawing, then retired the final man of that inning before giving way to Wilson, who put down the last six men in a row.

The loss for Robinson was his fifth of the year, but only his second in division play. It was his first division loss as a starter.

A big elimination tag team match pitting the Mighty Igor and Johnny Weaver against The Superstar and Kim Duk headlines the card.

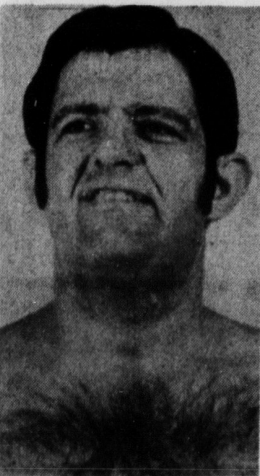
Other matches pit Crusher Blackwell against Red Bastien, Rick McGraw against Lanny Poffo and Bill Dromo against Larry Sharpe.
