

# County Fair Stock Shares Now On Sale

The Cleveland County Fair Board of directors at a meeting held May 5 authorized the offering for sale of up to five hundred (500) Shares of stock in the Cleveland County Fair at (\$100.00) one hundred dollars per share.

There hasn't been any new stock sold since the beginning of the fair in 1924. "The Board feels there is a new generation of people who would like to have an opportunity to buy stock in the Cleveland County Fair to help promote agriculture, industry, commerce, education and many other activities for the Cleveland County folks," said a spokesman.

The first USS North Carolina, was a frigate of the 1800's, the second was a World War I cruiser, and the third is a battleship now berthed at Wilmington, N. C.

More than 2-million gallons of fuel oil were used to fill the tanks of the Battleship USS North Carolina during her active duty days.

The funds arrived from the sale of shares in the Cleveland County Fair will be spent on capital improvements, mainly for a new Exhibit Building. The

present Exhibit Building has become more crowded every year. The Exhibit Building now houses education, 4-H Home Demonstration, farm

exhibits and all other exhibits, along with Commercial Booths.

"The Board feels that our County has changed a great deal in the past fifty

years, mainly from an agricultural county to a more diversified county, and other things should be shown along with our great agricultural program,"

added President Joe Goforth.

The new Exhibit Building will be an addition to present facilities, and can be used through-

out the year for functions that industry, or other organizations may need, such as shows for the public or sales to a particular group.

There has been quite lot of work already done on the Farmers Market, which plans to open at the Fairground June 14, said Goforth.
