The Sixth Fleet units were under the operational command of Vice Admiral Harry D. Train, II, in his NATO capacity as Commander, Naval Striking and Support Forces, Southern Europe.

A 1975 graduate of Kings Mountain High School, Sisk joined the Navy in May 1976.
