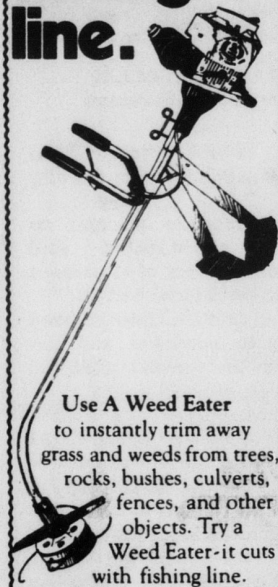

# Murder Trial Testimony Began

Testimony in the murder trial of Jimmy Green, 23, of Ulma, S. C., began in Cleveland County Superior Court Tuesday after day-long selection of a jury and two alternates Monday.

A tape-recorded confession allegedly made by the defendant in Baker's County, Fla. on Jan. 5, 1977, was ruled admissible as evidence by presiding Judge Forrest Ferrell.

The tape was introduced by SBI Agent Jim Woodard for a ruling by Judge Ferrell in the absence of a jury Monday.

Green has entered plea of not guilty to first degree murder and rape of Mrs. Rosemary Knauer, 45, of Daytona Beach, Fla., Penny Arcade operator at the Cleveland County Fair last Oct. 3, and his former employer.

Mrs. Green's partially-clothed body, with multiple stab wounds in the back, chest and abdomen, was found in a wooded area near Kings Mountain Inn on Oct. 4, 1976.

Testimony began immediately after the jury was sworn Tuesday when Kings Mountain Ptl. Mike Sanders of KMPD told of finding the body of Mrs. Knauer.
