Kings Mountain's American Legion Juniors host Forest City tonight before hitting the road for five straight Area Four Contests.

Shelby County in a makeup game last night, travel to Hickory Thursday and Cherrysville Saturday.

The Juniors dropped their third League One game in four outings Saturday at Lancaster Field as Shelby outgassed them 15-9.

The two teams combined for 28 hits, including 15 for Shelby and 13 for Post 155. Shelby led all the way, picking up three runs in the first inning and going on to a 10-6 lead after three.

Johnny Swink, the second Shelby hurler, was credited with the win. Steve McKee started for the visitors and exited after two and one-third innings.
