Dickson To Complete Study

The city commission Monday night retained the W. K. Dickson Company of Charlotte to complete the city's 201 sewer facility plan. Representative Ralph Johnson, who appeared before the board, said the project work had been underway for some time and was a part of the Gaston County Complex plan — a larger study composed of smaller ones by municipalities in the area including Gastonia, Mount Holly, Randle, Grover and Bessemer City. The larger study can't be done until the individual studies are completed, he said. Estimated cost to complete the study is \$55,108 and the board agreed that some portions of the study should be done by the city and the cost would be reduced.
