

# Abbey Tuition Is Reduced

Belmont Abbey College has increased its automatic tuition reduction to qualified students from Mecklenburg, Gaston, Cleveland and Lincoln counties by \$100. In the past, the College has reduced tuition for these students by \$200 per year, \$100 per semester. Beginning in the 1978-79 academic year, their tuition will be reduced by \$150 per semester or \$300 per year.

A "qualified student" is any present resident of Mecklenburg, Gaston, Cleveland, and Lincoln counties who also graduated from a high school in one of those counties. Once the student is accepted for admission to Belmont Abbey College as a full time student, he or she automatically receives the tuition reduction.

These students also receive an additional tuition reduction of \$300 per year from the state of North Carolina, a grant awarded all residents of North Carolina. Therefore, a student who qualified for both grants will automatically have his tuition reduced by \$600 per year.

Additional financial aid is available to students who show a need.

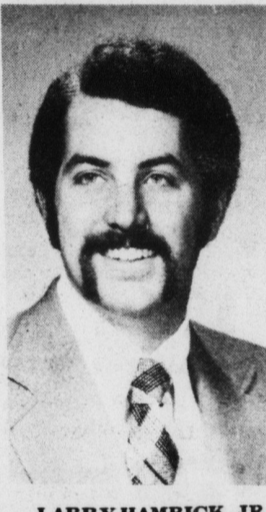

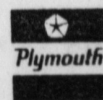
