In Federal Court

Thompson Convicted On Drug Charge

A car dealer from Kings Mountain, James Lawson Thompson, 50, and three other men were convicted Friday of conspiring to bring illegal drugs into North Carolina, according to federal court records.

The four, along with another man who was acquitted, were tried in U. S. District Court in

Charlotte on charges that they conspired to bring more than 400 pounds of marijuana and three and a half pounds of cocaine into North Carolina.

of Gaston County and Gustavo Otano Sanchez of Miami, were convicted of two counts. Sanchez was sentenced to two three year prison terms to run concurrently but Badia

was not sentenced. Acquitted was Felix Rafael Abreu of Miami. The star prosecution witness during the trial was Steven Charles Houser, 24, formerly of

Dallas, who implicated the five defendants in drug deals that totaled approximately \$100,000. The five were indicted by a federal grand jury in Charlotte last February.

According to U. S. Magistrate's records, the jury ended its deliberations last Friday and convicted Thompson on two counts. He was sentenced to two five-year prison terms to run concurrently.
