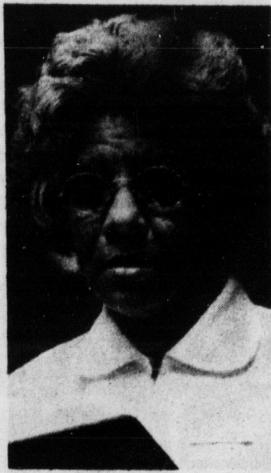


# Attend Food Service Meet

# Diabetes Meet Next Tuesday

The Cleveland County chapter of the American Diabetes Association will hold its bi-monthly educational meeting on Tues., March 20 at 7:30 p.m. at the Cleveland County Health Department on Grover Street next to the hospital in Shelby.

The speaker for the meeting will be Dan M. Campbell, a psychologist with the Cleveland County Mental Health Center. His topic will be: "Accepting things we cannot change: positive approach."

Sealed Proposals will be received by the City of Kings Mountain North Carolina, in the City Hall, in the Commissioners' Chambers, Kings Mountain, North Carolina, until 3:00 p.m. March 23, 1979, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and all bid prices read aloud, for the following:

All necessary furnishing of material and labor for the installation and construction of fencing of the Deal Street Recreation Park Little League Baseball Fields of the City of Kings Mountain.

No bid shall be considered or accepted by the City of Kings Mountain unless at the time of its filing, the same shall be accompanied by a deposit of cash or certified check on some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation in an amount equal to not less than five percent (5 percent) of the proposal. In lieu of making a cash deposit, the bidder may file a bid bond executed by a corporate surety, licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds, conditioned that the surety will, upon demand forthwith, make payment to the obligee upon said bond if the bidder fails to execute the Contract in accordance with the Bid Bond, and upon failure to forthwith make payment, the surety shall pay to obligee an amount equal to double the amount of the bid bond. This deposit shall be retained if the successful bidder fails to execute the Contract within fifteen (15) days after the award or fails to give satisfactory surety as required herein.

The successful bidder shall be required to enter into a Contract with the City of Kings Mountain in writing and shall be required to furnish bond on some surety company authorized to do business in the State, or make a deposit of money, certified check, or government securities for the full amount of said Contract for the faithful performance of terms of said Contract as required in Section 143-129 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.
