The Huttonsville, West Va., native coached 10 years at the high school level and had an overall record of 137-64. He coached at Kenbridge High, Bedford High and Pulaski High, all in Virginia. His 1962 team at Pulaski won the state championship with a 22-4 record and his 1965 Pulaski



team finished third in the state and had an undefeated regular season. He coached at Ferrum Junior College in Virginia year.

Tacy was elevated to the head job at Marshall in 1971-72 and compiled a 28-4 record He moved to Wake the following year and has led the Deacons to a 108-84 mark in seven years as head mentor.


