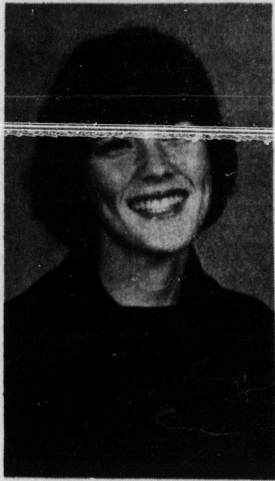


Lynches Attend Graduations

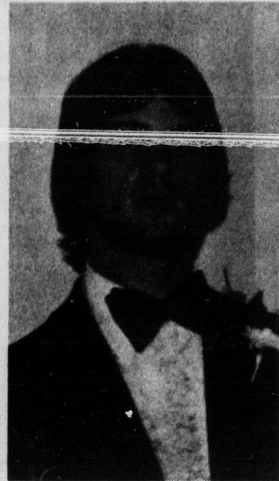

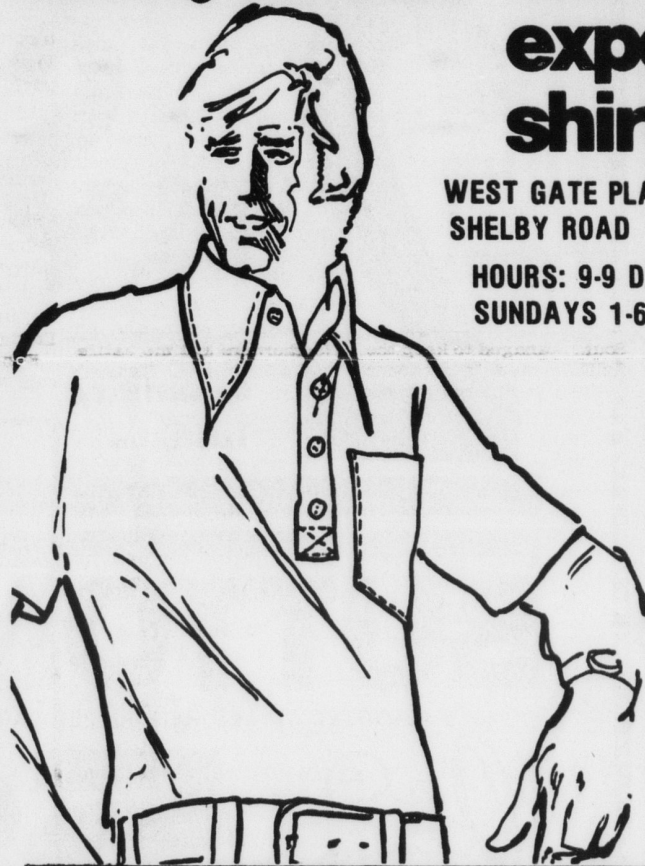
