A family birthday party was held Sunday afternoon at the Falls home and Cameron's Winnie-the-

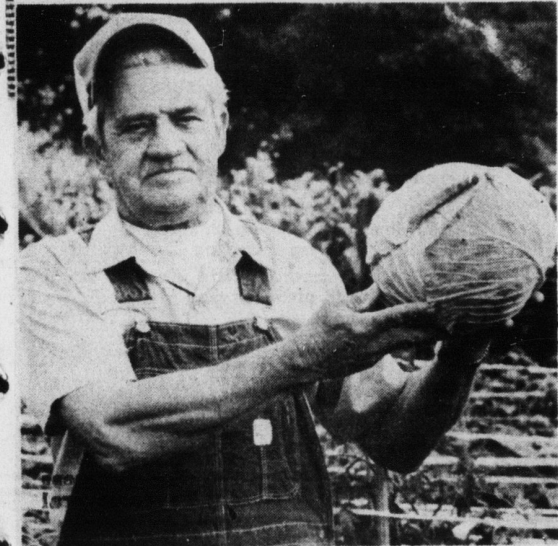
Pooh birthday cake was served with ice cream. Cameron's grandmother, Mrs. Joyce Hord, baked the cake.

Cameron is grandson of Mr. and Mrs. Paul Hord,

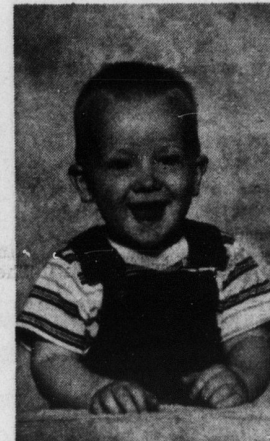
Jr. and Mr. and Mrs. Otis Falls, Jr., all of Kings Mountain.

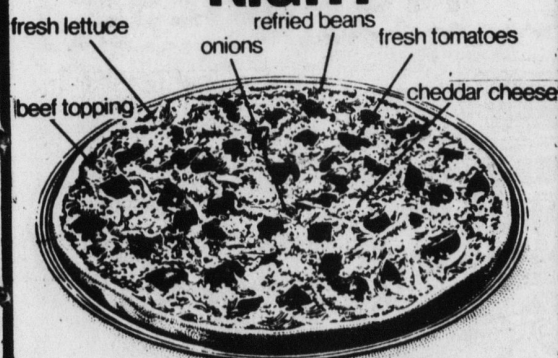

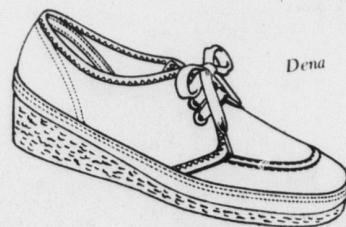

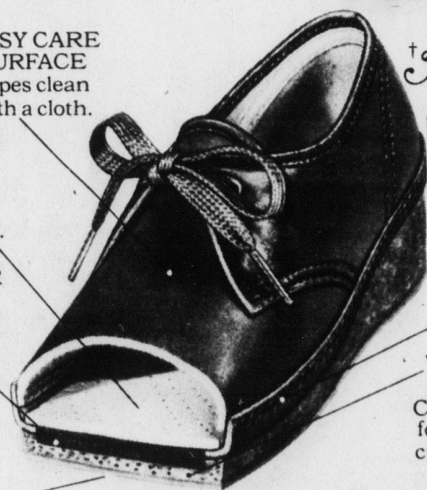
