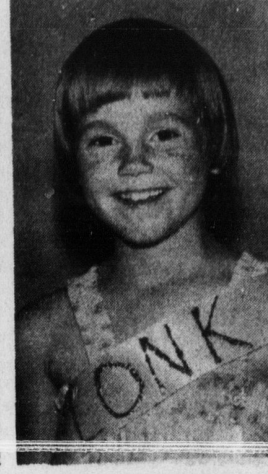
CAROL ANN VAN DYKE
