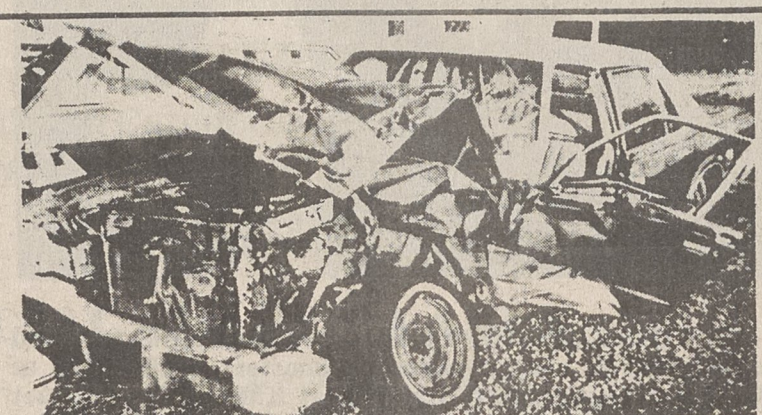
**EARNs DEGREE**
