Miller said she would like to see more of the system's positive news communicated while Smith said he would like to see the board be more responsive to citizen concerns.

"Personally, I don't think we've been to responsive to public concerns since I've been on the board," he said.

Smith and Miller both mentioned other concerns toward the end of the meet-

Miller said she would like to see more cultural arts recognition and Smith said he would like to see more accountability of people getting in free at high school football games.


