----- Are You Required To File NC Income Tax?-----

(EDITOR'S NOTE: This is the first in a series of articles on ways you can save money on your North Carolina State Income Tax return this year. The articles are prepared by H&R Block.)

All persons employed in North Carolina during the year will not be required to file a state income tax return.

So, before you actually get into preparing your North Carolina state income tax return, let's check to be sure you actually have to file one.

If you are a single resident of North Carolina or a married woman, and earned over \$1,000, or, a married man with income in excess of \$2,000, you are required to file a North Carolina state income tax return. Non-residents and part-year residents are also required to file if their income greater than their prorated exemptions.

If you now find that you must file a tax return, the first major step in preparing your return is to determine your personal exemptions. You


