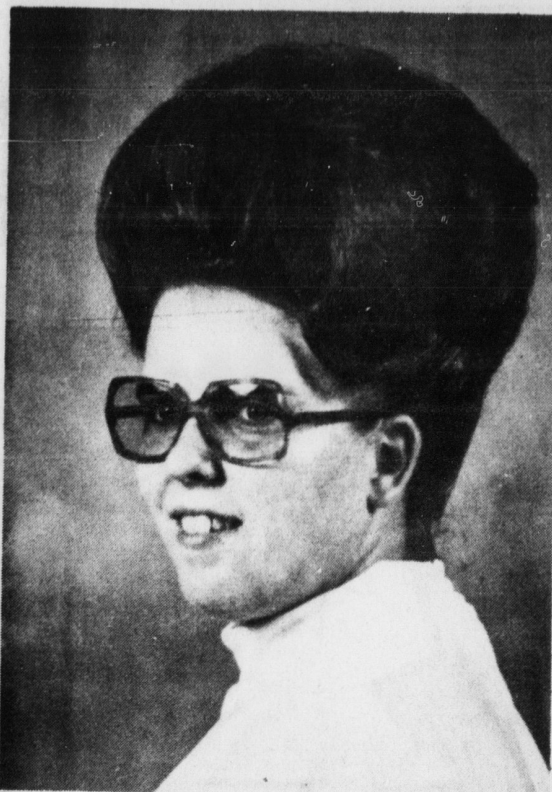
Presiding at the gift table were Mrs. Charlene Moss and Mrs. Vickie Moss.

The 15 guests showered the bride-to-be with gifts for her kitchen.

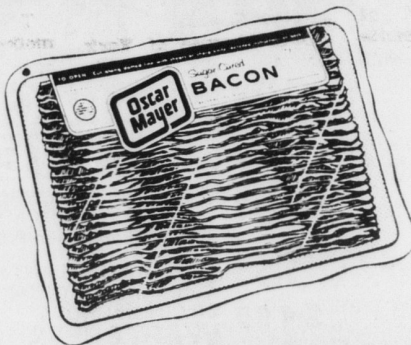
Miss Plonk was presented a daisy corsage to pin to the shoulder of her party dress.
