

KM Schools Announce Policy For Lunch Program

Kings Mountain District Schools today announced its policy for free and reduced price meals for children served under the National School Lunch, School Breakfast, and special Milk Programs.

Local school officials have adopted a family size income criteria for determining eligibility.

Children from families whose income is at or below the income levels are eligible for free or

reduced-price meals. In addition, families not meeting these criteria but with other unusual expenses due to unusually high medical expenses, shelter costs in excess of 30 percent of income, special

education expenses due to the mental or physical condition of a child, and disaster or casualty losses are urged to apply.

Application forms are being sent to all homes in a letter to parents. Ad-

ditional copies are available at the principal's office in each school. The information provided on the application is confidential and will be used only for the purpose of determining eligibility. Applications may be submitted at any time during the year. A simple statement of income and family size is required plus a signed certification by the parents or guardians that the information provided is correct.

In certain cases foster children are eligible for these benefits. If a family has foster children living with them and wishes to apply for such meals for them, it should contact the school.

Under the provisions of the policy the principal of each school will review applications and determine eligibility. If a parent is dissatisfied with the ruling of the official, he may wish to discuss the decision with the determining official on an in-

formal basis. If he wishes to make a formal appeal, he may make a request either orally or in writing to Martha H. Wright, 500 W. Parker St., Kings Mountain, N.C. 28086, or 739-7566 for a hearing to appeal the decision. The policy contains an outline of the hearing procedure.

If a family member becomes unemployed or if family size changes, the family should contact the school to file a new application. Such changes may make the children of

the family eligible for reduced price meals, or free meals if the family income falls at or below the levels shown above.

In the operation of child feeding programs, no child will be discriminated against because of race, sex, color, or national origin.

Each school and the office of the Superintendent and Food Service Director has a copy of the complete policy which may be reviewed by any interested party.

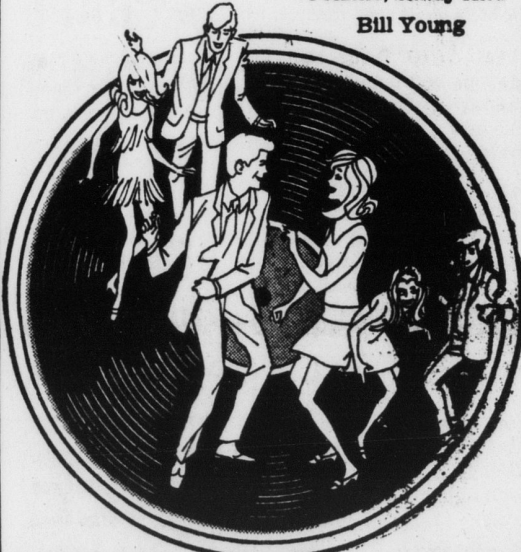
