## After Lord Appears, Gihon River Will Flow

John said, "He showed me a pure river of (literal) water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of...the Lamb (in Jerusalem) Rev. 22:1. This is the Gihon river 2 Ch. 32:30.

That same Gihon river from Paradise: "In that day, living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea (Dead Sea and Red Sea) and half of the waters toward the hinder sea; (Mediterranean sea) in summer and water it shall be" Zec. 14:8.

That same River from Paradise: "It shall come to pass in that day...a fountain (the Gihon Spring) shall come forth of

the house (Temple) of the Lord (in Jerusalem) and it will water the valley of Shittim" Joel 3:18.

Ezekiel's vision of the Gihon river which comes from inside the earth. "He brought me to the door of the house (Lord's Temple) and behold, waters... came down...like a river that I could not pass over... waters (deep enough) to swim in." The restored Gihon river may be a mile wide read Eze. 47:1-5.

Ezekiel tells us that fish and all sorts of sea creatures shall live in this Gihon river from that fisherman shall stand all along its shores. On the banks of this great river shall grow all sorts of food-trees. Their fruit will never fall. They will bear fresh fruit every month Eze. 47:8-12. Wherever this water of life flows it will change salt water into fresh water Eze. 47:9-11.

This Gihon river may flow through many countries before it flows into the ocean. Because of its pure water, the fish, the sea food, and free food, millions of people in towns and cities along its banks could live free without cost. "O Lord (Jesus) many are your wonderful works which you have done...They are more than can be numbered, Psa. 40:5.

Three-fourths of this

world is now under water. Over half of the dry land is an absolute waste of mountains, wilderness, and deserts. During the kingdom age our Lord Jesus will transform this dreary old world into a land of paradise.

Fresh water flowing through any kind of soil will produce grain, fruit, and vegetables. Over and over again our Lord has promised that He will supply rivers and

Just as the Gihon river from paradise will supply water for desert lands, so other rivers from paradise will supply water all over this world. Note:

Our Lord Jesus declares, "I will open up rivers in high places, and fountains in...the valleys. I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water" Isa.

41:18. "In the wilderness water will break out...and rivers in the desert" Isa. 43:20-25:6. "And parched ground shall become a pool; Isa. 35:7. "The solitary places shall be glad...and the desert shall blossom as the rose" Isa. 35:1. "The desolate land shall be tilled...and they shall say, this land that was desolate is become like the garden of Eden" Eze. 36:35. Plenty of fresh water on soil will produce

fruit, vegetables and grain.

You can believe it: Our Lord will keep every promise He ever made. During the coming Kingdom this whole world will become like that paradise inside the earth Eze. 36:35.

Gaston College Commencement Exercises will be held Sun., Aug. 26, 3 p.m. in the auditorium of the Myers College Center for 155 graduates.

All kindergarten students will attend on Thurs., Sept. 6. Kindergarten students will be on a half-day schedule (8:25-12 noon) through Sept. 13. Lunch will be available prior to dismissal time during these days.
