The state Land Records Management Program was begun by the North Carolina General Assembly in 1977 when enabling legislation created a small staff. The 1978 sessions of the General Assembly allocated \$75,00 for grants to counties for improvements in records systems. An additional \$75,000 for matching grants was budgeted by the legislature for the 1979-80 fiscal year.

The North Carolina Land Records Program is a part of the state Department of Administration.
