### KM Rescue Squad Report

Kings Mountain Rescue Squad made 107 trips totalling 2,016 miles during the month of August, Sgt. Roy Hammett reported in his monthly report Wednesday.

Volunteers worked 492 man hours, made 44 house calls, 25 transports, 54 emergency trips, 18 wrecks, 12 personal injuries, seven DOAs, six blood runs, assisted in 13 calls and conducted one training exercise with the Jaws of Life.

Hospital transports included 48 to Kings Mountain Hospital, eight to Kings Mountain Convalescent Center, nine to Cleveland Memorial, six to Gaston Memorial, five to Charlotte Memorial and one to Mercy Hospital.

## Hunt Announces Funds

Governor Jim Hunt announced this week the awarding of \$9,000 in state matching funds to Cleveland County to improve the county's land records system.

Governor Hunt said the grant was one of ten being made this year to counties for a total of \$75,000. "The state funds are being

matched on a 50-50 basis with local dollars as a part of the state Land Records Management Program," Hunt explained.

"Cleveland County has demonstrated a real interest in improving its system of land records management and these state funds will help the county in its effort," the

governor added. Governor Hunt said the county will receive the state funds at the completion of the project.

The county's project will involve preparation of large scale base maps.

Other counties receiving grants this year include: Ashe, Bladen, Chatham, Haywood, Hoke, Iredell, Jackson, Nash and Surry.

The state Land Records Management Program was begun by the North Carolina General Assembly in 1977 when enabling legislation created a small staff. The 1978 sessions of the General Assembly allocated \$75,000 for grants to counties for improvements in records systems. An additional \$75,000 for matching grants was budgeted by the legislature for the 1979-80 fiscal year.

The North Carolina Land Records Program is a part of the state Department of Administration.
