Donors will be processed from 10 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. at the Kings Mountain Citizens Service Center, near the city water tank, on North Piedmont Ave.

"We urge all citizens of the community to again come out and support the blood bank," said Mary W. Timms, executive director of the Cleveland County Red Cross Chapter.

Goal of the collection is 125 pints of blood.

A key objective of the Christmas Bazaar is to return to a simpler Christmas and eliminate the impersonal feeling and commercialism often experienced while Christmas shopping.
