2,848 Miles

In October

Kings Mountain Rescue Squad made 125 trips totalling 2,848 miles and members put in 563 man hours during the month of October.

The squad answered 61 house calls, made 30 transports, four blood runs, 55 emergencies, 14 wrecks, assisted in 15 calls, answered four fires and one training exercise.

Hospital trips included 56 to Kings Mountain Hospital, six to Kings Mountain Convalescent Center, one to Raleigh, one to Duke, 15 to Cleveland Memorial, four to Gaston Memorial, two to Charlotte Memorial and one each to Presbyterian, Gaston Rehabilitation Center and Gaffney.
