"We have spent most of our practice time working on fundamentals," said Albergine. "Our biggest assets are our overall team quickness and the good attitude all the players have shown. We're really getting a good effort from everyone and that's what it's going to take if we are to have a good season."

Albergine has named Curry and Hamrick co-captains and says she's looking for them to provide leadership.

"Picking a favorite is tough, but I'll have to go with Burns since they are the only team that beat our jayvees twice last year. We can't afford to take any team lightly, especially the teams in our division, if we hope to make the playoffs. Right now, that is our primary goal."

Losing out in the championship finals were Joey Wyte, who was decisioned by Ashbrook's Andy Keller in the 98 pound class; Miles Boyce, who was pinned by South Point's Tracy Schiff in the 112 pound finals; Bernard Womic, who was pinned by Darren Phillips of Ashbrook in 132 pounds; and Kenny Womic, who was pinned by Ashbrook's 195-pounder, David Colvin.
