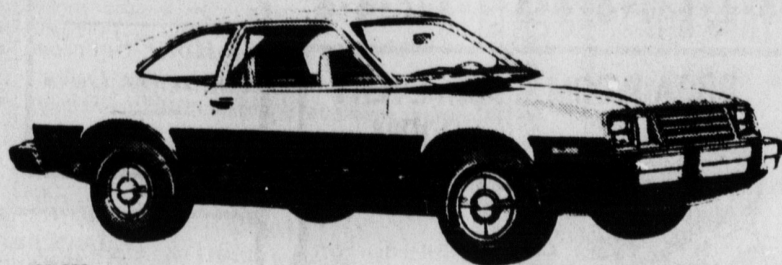
The Lottie Moon Christmas offering will be received at the Sunday worship hour and goal is \$1,000 for foreign missions.
