Ralph Gilbert will instruct the 72-hour class which will meet each Tuesday and Thursday, from 7 to 10 p.m., beginning with the second meeting. The class will end on March 20.

According to Dan T. Camp, dean of Tech's Continuing Education Department, requirements for completion of the course, as set by the N.C. Real Estate Licensing Board, are an attendance record of 80 percent or better and a

passing score of at least 70 percent on the final examination as administered by the instructor. Those successfully completing these requirements are then qualified to take the State's Salesman or Brokers licensing examination.

A \$5.00 registration fee is required at the first class meeting. The necessary textbook may be purchased from the campus bookstore.

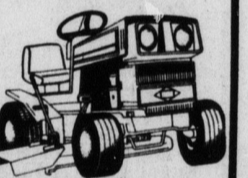
The nature of the relief being sought against you is as follows: An absolute divorce based upon more than one (1) year of separation.
