Kings Mountain High's jayvee footballers spotted East Gaston a 6-0 lead, then came back for a 12-8 win in Southwestern Conference jayvee action Thursday afternoon at East Gaston.

The Little Mountaineers, 3-3, host Shelby Thursday night at 7:30.

East Gaston scored its lone touchdown with two minutes left in the half and went for a two-point conversion to make the score 8-0.

Two plays after the kickoff, William Short went 60 yards behind some good downfield blocking by Philip Scism and Tom Potter to make the score 8-6 at intermission.

Max Brooks scored on a 45 yard run, breaking several tackles along the way, in the fourth period to make the final score 14-8.

"Except for the defensive let-

down when East Gaston drove for its only touchdown, we played a real good game," commented Coach Charlie Burns. "I was a little better satisfied with the offense, which finally put some points on the board."

Kings Mountain rushed for 148 yards, with Short and Brooks accounting for most of them on the two long touchdown runs. Kings Mountain had the ball on the East three yard line when the final gun sounded.
