Inspires Shaw U. Audience:
"College Students Should Build Personality" - Bando

College students should build for themselves a type of personality that will enhance their academic training, Dr. Thelma P. Bando, dean of women at Morgan State College, told her Shaw University audience on Monday, March 2.

She stated that in the curriculum of every school, from the upper elementary grades to the university, a core program of general education for all students, irrespective of their specialized interests, should be emphasized. She pointed out that no educational program should narrow its objectives to exclude preparation for citizenship, citizenship must be taught explicitly - every student must know of democratic processes, values, and ethical aims, and must understand the forces that threaten democracy.

Recently, the McCall-sponsored tour of the U. S. by Pierre Cardin, a leading Paris creator, the first such tour by any top name designer, to be sponsored by a U. S. pattern company, pointed up this very fact: that patterns are now translating a \$300 to \$500 design into terms of a fifty cent to \$1.00 pattern.
