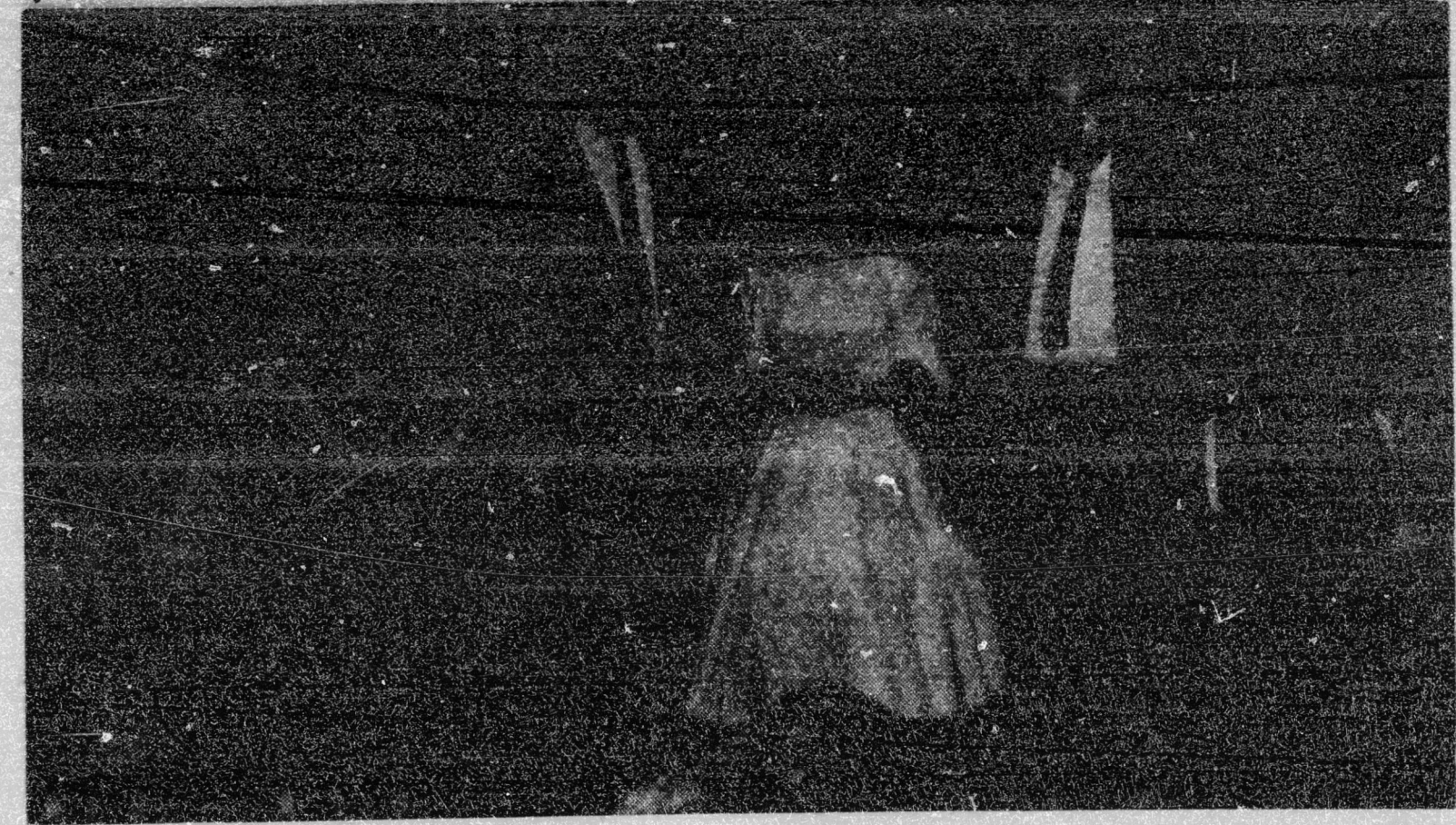

Nat'l Science Foundation Grants
St. Aug. Money For Science Inst.

St. Augustine's College has received a grant from the National Science Foundation to conduct an In-Service Institute for Secondary Mathematics Teachers during the academic year 1959-60. The object of the Institute will be to improve the subject matter competence of the participating teachers to strengthen the capacity of these teachers to motivate students to consider careers in science and to bring these teachers into personal contact with the competent scientists of the Institute. This is the third grant received by St. Augustine's College from the National Science Foundation. At the present time, a Mathematics Institute is being held on campus for teachers of Mathematics. During the summer an Institute will be held for high school teachers of mathematics and science. Persons taking the course will receive four hours of under-graduate credit. Meharry To Host Famous Scientist From Germany

NASHVILLE, Tenn. — Dr. Feodor Lynen, from Munich, Germany, will be the guest of Meharry Medical College March 25 - 28. He is a biochemist of international repute. His visit will be made possible through the courtesy of the Squibb Centennial Lecture Committee. The eminent visitor will deliver several lectures at Meharry. His only public appearance will be at 10:30 a. m., March 28, in the Public Health Lecture Hall of the college. Dr. Lynen will arrive in the United States on March 25. A biochemist of international repute, Dr. Lynen was born in Munich on April 6, 1911, and received his Ph. D. from Munich University. He was lecturer in chemistry at Munich University in 1942 and became Professor of Chemistry in 1947, a position which he has held since that time. He is also the Director of the Institute for Cell Chemistry, German Psychiatric Research Institute (Max Planck Institute), Munich. He has contributed numerous papers to scientific journals dealing with many aspects of the biological degradation of acetic acid, the nomenclature of enzymes involved in fatty acid metabolism and of the amines of cysteine and tyrosine.
