Baha'is Set 51st Confab For Wilmette

WILMETTE, Ill. (ANP) — The fifty-first national Baha'i convention will be held at the Baha'i House of Worship here in Wilmette, from Thursday, April 23 to April 26. Some 700 delegates and observers from every state in the Union, including Alaska and Hawaii, and from Puerto Rico, expect to attend the four day conference.

Purpose of the convention is to elect the National Spiritual Assembly for the coming year and to consult on the goals still to be attained in the ten-year spiritual crusade inaugurated in 1953. Major consideration will be given to the home front, according to the National Assembly.

The establishment of an additional 102 local assemblies; increased teaching effort in the need for more pioneers and resident teachers here and abroad.

Among the world-wide goals already achieved, the statement continues, are the opening of the Baha'i Home for the Aged and the completion of the Temple gardens in Wilmette; the erection of the Baha'i International Archives on Mt. Carmel, Haifa, Israel International headquarters of the Faith; the purchase of 12 sites for future temple; and the construction of two temples, one in Africa and the other in Australia.

More than 50 national administrative headquarters have been purchased, and endowments founded in some 60 capital and chief cities. Since the beginning of the crusade, the Baha'i Faith has spread from 128 to 256 countries and territories with the number of Baha'i centers increasing from 1,800 to over 5,000.

The unity honors that the world is achieving do not last beyond the next few years.
