Horton Faces Liquor Rap In Fed. Crack-Down Here

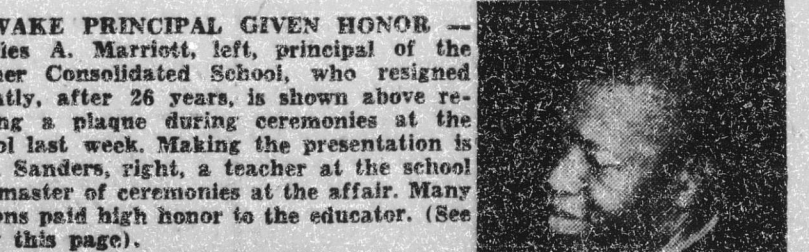

Monroe's NAACP Prexy Asks Sons' Admittance

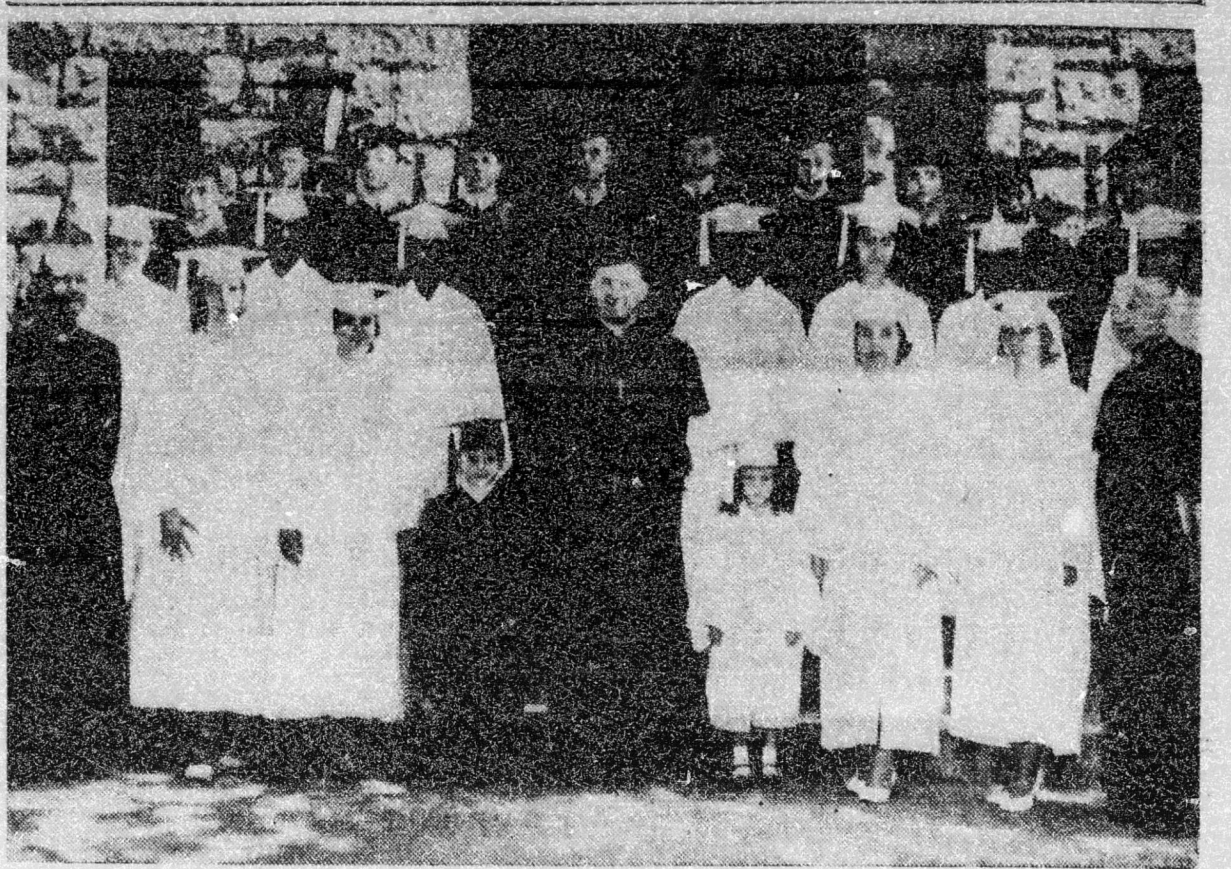
MONROE — Integration may begin in the Monroe public school system this fall if an application made by the father for his two sons is favorably considered.
