Rental Restrictions **Block Complete** Integration

ST. LOUIS - The Missouri Advisory Committee of the Federal Commission on Civil Rights reported recently that 95 per cent of Negro school children in Missouri are attending desegregated

However, the report pointed out that residential segregation has resulted in a large percentage of Negro children attending schools that are, in fact. Negro schools. Some high schools remain as segregated as before the 1954 decision of the United States Supreme

The committee said school integration would "remain a mockery" so long as "free choice in homebuying and renting" was denied.

The Missouri school board made plans for complete integration af ter the court decision in 1954. The plans were endorsed by the various communities.


