

## Over 5,000 Students Tested During Hampton's Program

HAMPTON, Va. — Over 5,000 students were tested during the 1952-53 academic year by the Cooperative Intercollegiate Examination Program, according to Calvin H. Raulerson, National Director, speaking at the ninth annual planning conference held on the Hampton Institute campus last week.

Attended by delegates from 36 private colleges, all member institutions of United Negro College Fund, it was decided to change the dates of the testing program during the coming year to conform with deadlines for scholarship applications and college admissions. The testing period this year will be held November 30 through December 12.

Dr. H. C. Hamilton, registrar at Morehouse College, Atlanta, Ga., was elected chairman of the planning conference and chairman of the executive committee. Dr. S. O. Roberts, chairman, department of psychology, Fisk University, Nashville, Tenn., and Moses S. Belton, director of Public Relations, Johnson C. Smith University, Charlotte, N. C., were elected members of the executive committee. Also elected was Miss Anna M. Sewall, registrar of Dillard University, New Orleans, La., as secretary of the Planning Conference.

The next annual meeting will be held May 6 and 7 in New York City, according to Mr. Raulerson.

Founded in 1952, with 13 participating colleges, the Cooperative Intercollegiate Examination Program, has grown during the past six years to include 30 of the 33 UNCF colleges. The program has grown from 84 testing centers until today it embraces 260 centers located in 30 states.

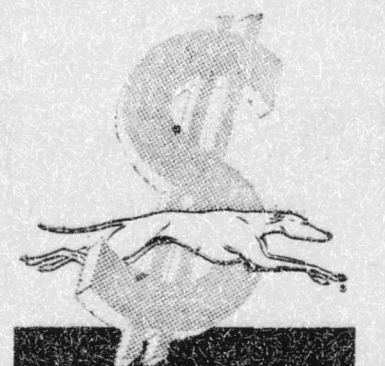

**WHITE HOME IN NEGRO NEIGHBORHOOD**—This is the combination store-home in the Negro neighborhood in Jackson, Miss. which the white family of Mr. and Mrs. W. J. Garrett and their three teen-age daughters has lived for the past two years. However, some 82 Negroes have signed a petition asking that the white family be refused a permit to build a "permanent" home in their section. The petition to the Hinds County Board of Supervisors said, "Mr. Garrett has three teen-age daughters and, of course there are a lot of young colored boys in this area. We do not want anything to happen which would cause any trouble." Garrett claims that the petition is the first indication he has had of Negro objections. "No one ever said anything," he stated. ## SAC CONDUCTING EXERCISE

The Strategic Army Corps is conducting a Command Post Exchange during the period 26 October to 9 November in South Carolina, North Carolina and Virginia. This exercise is called DRAGON HEAD.

A Command Post Exchange is a limited maneuver in which only the Commanders and the Staffs participate. The soldiers of the fighting units remain in their home stations. The headquarters of each unit will move from place to place as the operation progresses. Commanders will be forced, by conditions laid down by the scenario of the problem to meet certain conditions, and to make decision on the employment of the troops and weapons just as if they were present.

A system of Controllers operate in these exercises commonly known as CPX's. These Controllers guide the scenario according to a master plan by entering certain situations into the problem as they would normally occur in war. The Commander therefore must make decisions without any prior warning of the conditions which may be encountered in the future.

You can see the money saving features of such an exercise. The Commanders and the Staffs get a stiff workout, without the expense of moving troops over long distances, and without the resultant wear and tear on equipment, and the farmer's land.

Of course some troops must be present to furnish the telephones and radio communications required by the Commanders and their Staffs.

You are welcome to visit any of the Command Posts which will pass through your area. Each unit will have an Information Officer to assist you or your representative.

## Permanent Civil Rights Commission Urged To Prevent Vote Rights Denial

**NEW YORK** — The American Jewish Congress this week called for the establishment of a permanent Civil Rights Commission and urged prompt Federal intervention to prevent the "outrageous" denial of voting rights to Negroes as practiced in some Southern states.

In a statement hailing the report of the Commission, Shad Polier, chairman of the AJCongress Commission on Law and Social Action, declared:

"Our Republic came into being because Americans were denied the right to participate in their own government. The right to vote is the very foundation of our American democracy.

When certain states are defiant in their obligation to carry out the letter and spirit of the constitutional right to vote, the Federal Government has the responsibility to intervene for the protection of this right."

Mr. Polier said that "guaranteeing the right to vote is the most important and effective way of ensuring equal treatment in other..."
