"Strive For Excellence:"

Dr. John Hope Franklin Sparks Faculty At Saint Augustine's

Speaking on "The Role of the College in Developing an Atmosphere Conducive to Learning" Dr. John Hope Franklin, chairman, department of History at Brooklyn College, urged the faculty at St. Augustine's to strive for excellence in their teaching and from their students.

Dr. Franklin was introduced by President James A. Boyer, who opened the 53rd year at St. Augustine's College this week by speaking on "Launching the 1959-60 School Year." Dr. Franklin said that teachers must recognize the fact that students today want the best, they expect it and will demand it.

"Buildings and grounds do not make a college," he said, but an institution must seek scholarly learning, seek a vital meaningful curriculum, one that seeks the stu-

dent's full capacity. Dr. Franklin concluded by stating that a college must attain and hold the faculty—one that is dedicated to learning. He said that there are three indispensable qualities of good teachers: they must be good campus citizens; successful and dedicated teachers; and be creative in their own field.
