Victim Is Kicked By Policemen

Five Cleveland Heights, Ohio policemen were indicted last week by a federal grand jury on charges of beating and kicking a prisoner in a jail cell

jury on charges of beating and kicking a prisoner in a Jail cell.

Attorney General William B. Saxbe said the indictment was returned in U.S. District Court in Cleveland, Ohio, against Detectives Edward C. Smith, Roland A. Salcer, Joseph M. Sas, Peter J. Previte, and Robert O. Kral.

The indictment said the five violated the constitutional right of Sherman D. Howard.
26. of the Cleveland area, not to be deprived of liberty without due process of law. Howard was allegedly kicked and beaten in the Geauga County Safety Center in Chardon, Ohio, near Cleveland on Aug. 22, 1972, after he had been taken into custody on a narcotice charge.

Howard, who is black, was taken to a hospital for treatment. The five detectives are white.

Howard is now confined to the London, Ohio, correctional facility for possession of narcotics and escape.

Assistant Attorney General J. Stanley Pottinger, head of the Civil Rights Division, said the maximum penalty upon conviction is a year in prison and a \$1,000 fine


