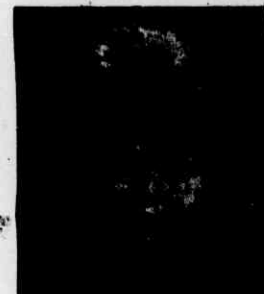
The Open Meeting for December will involve participating in a holiday party to be held for children at a local community day care center. For more information about this program contact Dorothy Shapiro at 847-0371.
