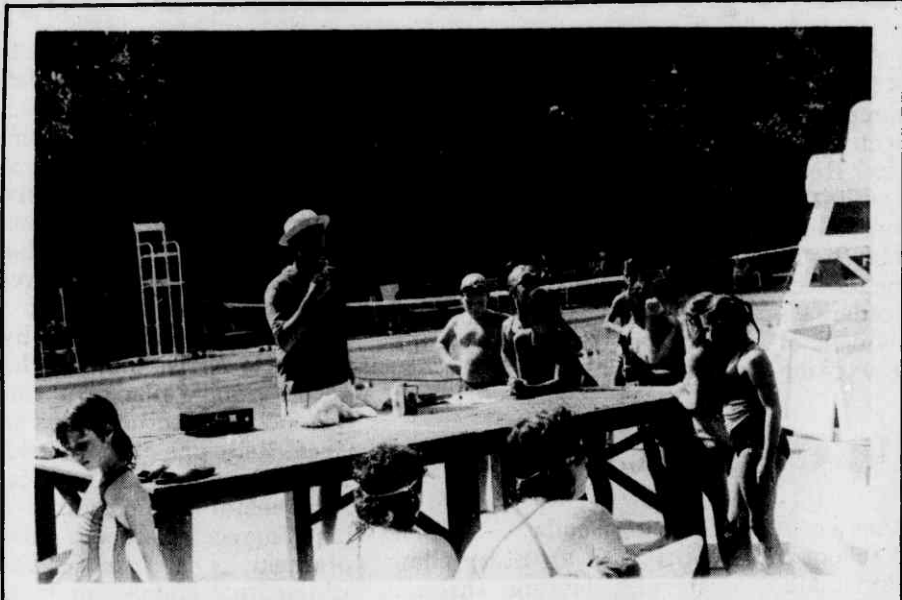

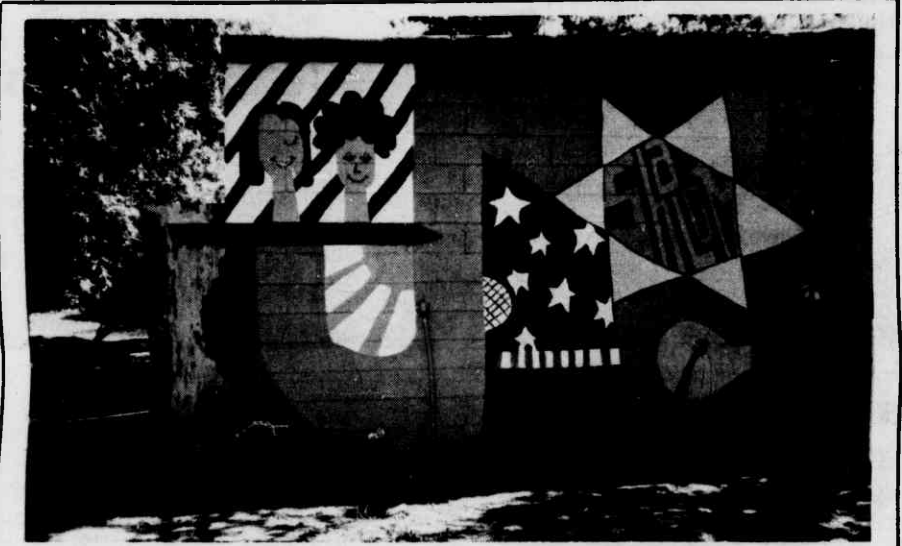
“Looking Forward to the New JCC”



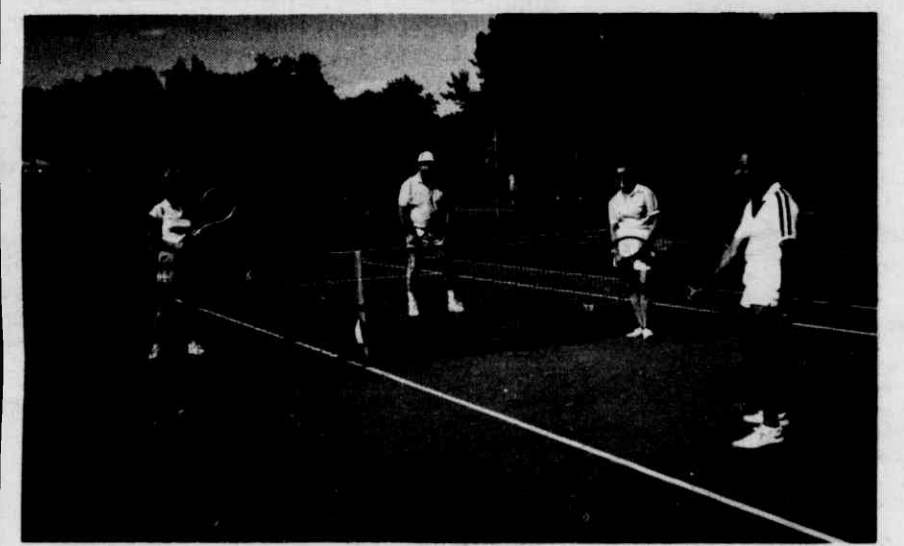

Part of Labor Day crowd enjoying the final hours on the 'J's old site.



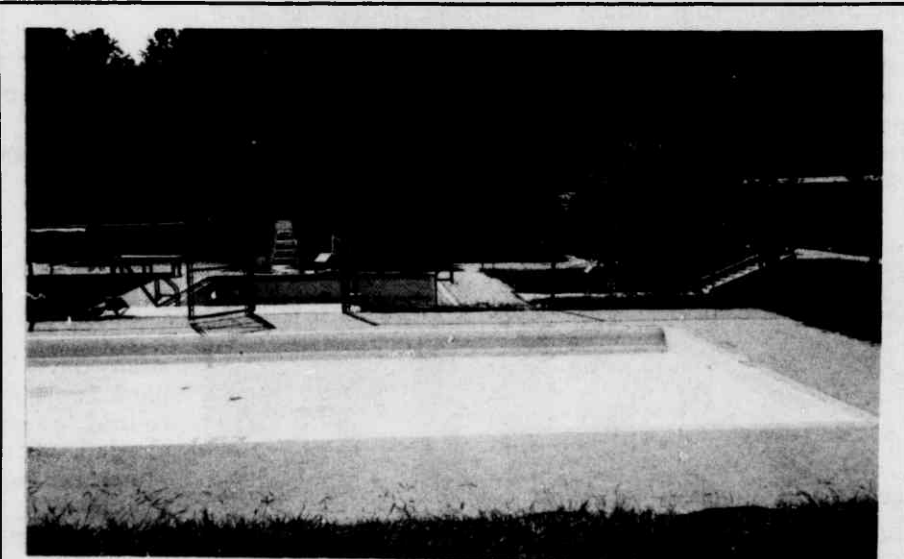
Utility Shed, miraculously saved from the fire, which was decorated by the children.
