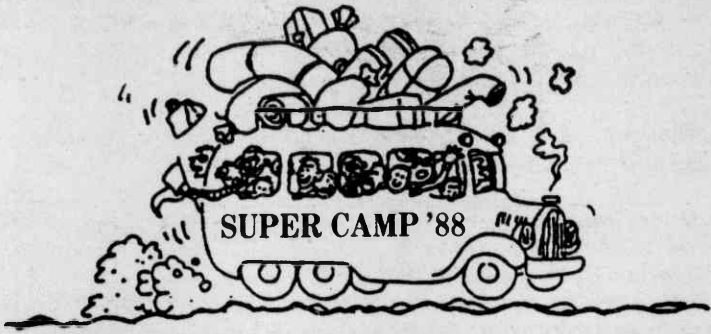


It's Time to Think About JCC Summer Camps 1988

- The fourth day of creation: "Let There Be the Stars, the Moon, the Sun and Seasons"—Grade 3
- The fifth day of creation: "Let Living Creatures Fill the Waters of the Sea and the Expanse of the Sky"—Grade 2
- The sixth day of creation: "Let the Earth Bring Forth Animals and Human Kind"—Grade 1
- The seventh day of creation: "Let This be a Day of Rest"—Grade K
