Tid-Bits

NEW YORK (JTA) — The Carolyn Zelaznik Gruss Life Monument Jewish Educational Center, which was dedicated in Starrett City, will be the first and only school in the U.S. solely for Russian immigrant children. With substantial funding pledged by Jewish philanthropists Joseph Gruss and Albert Reichmann, the Be'er Hagolah Institutes, previously scattered in five different locations throughout Brooklyn, will have its own headquarters and space for 600 more students, more than double its current enrollment.

NEW YORK (JTA) — 74 young men and women from 18 federations throughout North America, the largest number of participants to date, flew to Israel to begin a year of volunteer service.

The group was a part of Project Otzma, a program sponsored by the Council of Jewish Federations, the Israel Forum, the Jewish Agency and the Youth & Hechalutz Department of the World Zionist Organization.

NEW YORK (JTA) — A dramatic increase in the number of American Jews remaining single will impact significantly on the future of the American Jewish family, according to a recent sociological study by a Brandeis University research associate.

NEW YORK (JTA) — To welcome the New Year, Hadasah has purchased 5,750 trees to be planted in the Carmel Range in Israel. The new trees will help replace some of those lost to a devastating series of fires which incinerated 800 to 1,200 acres of forest on September 19.


