

Honda cars assembled at the Ohio plant of the Honda of America Co., the U.S. subsidiary of the Japanese firm.

The cars made in Ohio are expected to go on sale in Israel beginning next summer.

At least 25 percent of the parts come from Japan, where Honda has heeded the Arab boycott for years.

Although Honda of America guaranteed the parts when the export deal was concluded several months ago, the Israeli Foreign Ministry insisted on a public statement from Honda headquarters in Tokyo as a condition for importing the cars into Israel.

Four smaller Japanese auto manufacturers have been selling cars in Israel for several years. They are Mitsubishi, Subaru, Daihatsu and Suzuki.

The Toyota Motor Co., Japan's largest, still does not do business with Israel.

## Tid-Bits

WASHINGTON (JTA) — B'nai B'rith launched a Panama disaster relief drive to aid the nation devastated by fighting and looting in the wake of the U.S. invasion to oust dictator Manuel Noriega.

NEW YORK (JTA) — They employ different methods, but two Reform synagogues in San Francisco and Pittsburgh have achieved the same results — the successful integration of recently

arrived Soviet Jewish emigre families into the religious, cultural and social life of their communities.

Both programs were praised at the recent convention of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, the congregational arm of Reform Judaism in the United States.

CHICAGO (JTA) — The Jewish Federation of Metropolitan Chicago has offered a \$5,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of anti-Semitic vandals who spray painted swastikas and "Kill All Jews" on the exterior walls of the Jacob Duman Jewish Community Building in suburban Buffalo Grove. Several windows were broken and a bomb threat, the fourth this past year, was telephoned to the center.

WASHINGTON (JTA) — President Bush has nominated Kitty Dukakis to the 65-member U.S. Holocaust Memorial Council.

WASHINGTON (JTA) — President Bush played dreidel at the White House, first getting a no-decision on "nun" and then winning a pot of chocolates on "gimmel." Bush played with

students from the Charles E. Smith Day School here as part of the first large-scale Chanukah celebration at the White House.

NEW YORK (JTA) — MIFNE, the Hebrew word for "turnaround," is the acronym for an Israeli project that will try to help rehabilitate the estimated eight percent of that country's adolescents who have dropped out of society.

The program, adopted by the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee, was developed initially in partnership with the government and the Jerusalem municipality.

SAN FRANCISCO (JTA) — Scores of stickers bearing black swastikas with the words "Inflation is Jewish" and "Death to Race-Mixers" were found on windshields and windows of businesses around San Francisco recently.

The stickers contain the address of New Order Publications, Box 6414, Lincoln, Neb. 68506.

SAN FRANCISCO (JTA) — A Jewish film festival, scheduled to take place in Moscow from March 24 to 31, will offer 25 of the best contemporary Jewish-subject films worldwide.
