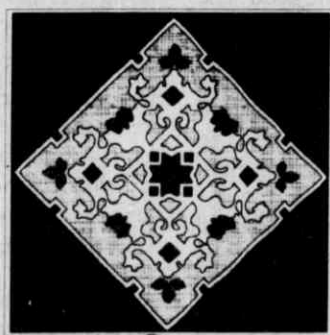
Jeffrey Huberman is the new president of the N.C. chapter of the American Institute of Architects.
