

Summer Break Is No Vacation For NC Hillel

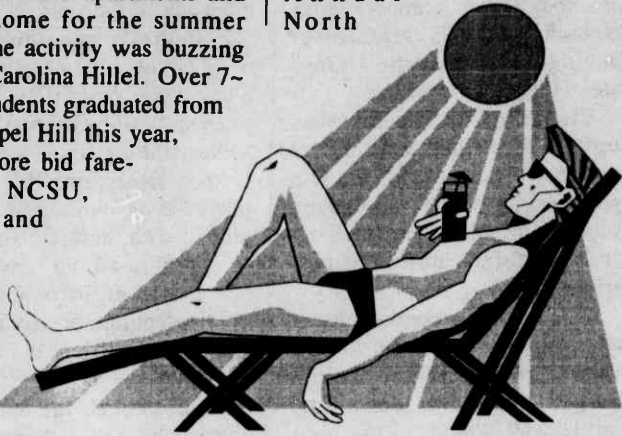
